COVID-19 STUDENT TESTING REQUIREMENTS: SPRING 2021



DO I NEED TO TEST?

I tested positive for COVID-19 within the 90-day window before my planned return.	No test required.* <u>Upload non-Penn State test to</u> <u>myUHS</u> for review and approval.	
I am learning remotely from home, will not be on campus during the spring semester, AND my home is more than 20 miles away from a Penn State Campus.	No test required.	
I am learning remotely from home, will not be on campus during the spring semester, AND my home is <u>within</u> 20 miles of a Penn State Campus (including World Campus students).	Testing required. Request a test as soon as possible.	
I am returning to my campus community, but all of my classes are remote.	Testing required. Use testing schedule below.	
I am returning to campus and have in-person classes and/or on-campus commitments.	Testing required. Use testing schedule below.	
I am not returning to campus but have an approved internship, clinical, practicum or other in-person learning experience.	Testing required. Use testing schedule below	
I remained in my campus community over winter break (including graduate, international, and off-campus students).	Testing required. Request a test as soon as possible.	

* Once the 90-day window ends, students should resume all University testing requirements.

YOUR PRE-SEMESTER TESTING CHECKLIST:

I am ready to arrive/have met testing requirements when I have:

Received a negative COVID-19 test result by the date determined in the testing schedule

OR

- Tested positive in the 90 days prior and, if necessary, uploaded my third-party positive test results and received verification. (It is not necessary to upload test results from a Penn State testing process such as Vault Health or through health services on your campus.)
- Checked the <u>Know Your Status</u> portal to confirm I have completed the requirements.
